STUDENT DROP-OFF

RHS 10-12 Bldg – preferred drop-off is in the senior parking lot. If you do drop off using the main entrance, please **pull all the way to the cross walk to avoid cars being backed up onto Kroes Road.**

RFC- Drop off at the west side entrance; please do not **ENTER** through the **EXIT** on Northland Dr. Do not drop off students at the 4-way stop.

STUDENTS TRAVELING BETWEEN BUILDINGS

Between hours, buses will be located in front of each building; students are required to use the service. The bus will depart when the bell rings to end class. Students will be released three minutes prior to the bell and allowed to arrive three minutes late. Based on classroom location, staff will make the appropriate arrangements if these times need to be adjusted. However, establishing a concrete arrival time in order to hold students accountable is imperative.

ABSENCES –If a student is to be absent, please remember to call the attendance office between the hours of 7:00 am – 3:30 pm on the day of the absence.
