Adoption of Agenda

Motion to approve agenda by Jake Himmelspace with support by Tricia Anderson. Motion passed unanimously.

Recognition

A video was played honoring the Middle School Students of the Month for both January and February. Mandy Scott was recognized for being the Michigan Vocal Teacher of the Year.

New Business

RHS Tennis Courts Bid Approval

Executive Director of Business and Operations, Allison Clements introduced representatives from OAK Construction, GMB Architecture and Rockford Public Schools Director of Operations. Jared Gauss from OAK showed a layout of the new tennis courts and explained the logistics of the area. 12 new tennis courts will be added just behind the weight room at the High School with the existing courts remaining until the project of the new courts is complete. The old courts will then be removed and become green space. The project will be finished in early August in time for the fall season.

Motion to approve by Nick Reichenbach with support by Tricia Anderson. Motion passed unanimously.

Valley View Bus Loop and Parking Lot Concept Approval

This project is an opportunity to remove some portables and do some paving work and bus loop reconfiguration. Tom VanDeGriend from GMB Architecture showed a view of the site concept and the enlargement of the loop to make more room for buses and making it safer for the students on the sidewalk. This will also increase the parent loop which will help with traffic in the road. This project will be done before the start of the 2024-2025 school year. Bid process will begin February 28 with the final approval on the March Board Agenda.

Motion to approve by Kelley Freridge with support by Jake Himmelspach. Motion passed unanimously.

Classroom A/V Multimedia System Bid Approval

Executive Director of Business and Operations, Allison Clements introduced Chris Meuser from Communications By Design and Rockford Public Schools Director of Operational Technology, Bob Stull. This is a District wide improvement project of the classroom A/V system adding new projectors, screens and upgrading A/V components that allows wireless connections from laptops to the screen. Also adding new laptop docking stations in each room and adding teacher amplification to make every room consistent. This is a continuation of the same design that was implemented at Meadow Ridge and Belmont.

Motion to approve by Kelley Freridge with support by Jake Himmelspach. Motion passed unanimously.

Bond Refunding Ratifying Resolution

Executive Director of Business and Operations, Allison Clements talked about the refinancing of some bonds with very successful bond pricing.

Motion to approve by Nick Reichenbach with support by Tricia Anderson. Motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote.

Capital Improvement Fund Resolution for Prevailing Wage

Superintendent, Dr. Steve Matthews talked about some legislative changes that were passed in the fall regarding prevailing wage. Allison Clements explained how the new prevailing wage set by the State of Michigan will impact Rockford Public Schools projects.

Motion to approve by Kelley Freridge with support by Nick Reichenbach. Motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote.

MASB Labor Strategies Update

Nick Reichenbach attended the MASB Labor Conference and gave an update. The meeting covered the PARA Act along with discussions around evaluations.

Furniture Purchase

Assistant Superintendent, Mike Ramm talked about the furniture purchase as the district updates learning environments. This bid is for Teacher furniture for Edgerton Trails, Roguewood Elementary and Valley View Elementary. Student furniture for Valley View is also in the packet. This is the second large bid with one more scheduled for the March Board meeting.

Motion to approve by Kelley Freridge with support by Tricia Anderson.

Motion passed with a roll call vote of 6 yes and 1 abstained.

Old Business

Special Policy Updates

Special policy updates are being presented to the board for a second reading. Dr. Korie Wilson-Crawford explained that these policies help us stay aligned with current school codes. These updates are regarding evaluations and PERA updates which take effect on February 13, 2024. There are ten policy changes.

Motion to approve by Jake Himmelspach with support by Tricia Anderson. Motion passed unanimously.

Attendance Boundaries

Dr. Steve Matthews discussed the new elementary boundary lines with the new school opening in August 2024. After several district meetings there were three exceptions made. The district will begin the communication process this week. Every resident family with an elementary school student will receive an email that includes a link of the new boundary lines and what their new resident building will be. In District Transfer instructions will be included in the email with a link to complete the In-District Transfer form.

School of Choice will open after the In District Transfer window closes.

Dr. Matthews asked the Board to approve the new attendance boundary lines.

Camille Dahlke updated the board on the many current events that have been taking place across the district. The Choral Gala took place on February 11th having the High School students collaborating with the Middle School students. Tickets are on sale for the musical Mamma Mia which will take place in March.

Collaborative Team Reports

Meadow Ridge Elementary Principal, Blake Bowman discussed the two pilots in English Language Arts. Phoenix the counseling dog has joined the Lakes Elementary Staff. Mr. Bowman also talked about the NWEA assessment with a future date for a data summit meeting. Martin Luther King Day was celebrated with a feature on the local news. Parent teacher conferences will be at the end of the second trimester. Belmont fourth graders participated at Zoo School for a week. Roguewood Elementary recently went to see the Peter Pan play. Crestwood is launching their Book Bingo in March. Meadow Ridge was the winner of the battle of the books. Meadow Ridge is one of 5 schools that have been recognized with an early literacy award.

Rockford Freshman Center Principal, Dr. Kelly Amshey shared that the process of welcoming the next group of students for 2024-2025. Secondary is also actively engaged in NWEA and at the Middle Schools Dibels as well. State assessments are right around the corner. North Middle School making the most of their RAM time in a variety of ways. River Valley Academy is looking into the college and career prep by helping students get ready for mock interviews. Student appreciation week was held at Rockford Freshman Center to recognize the students for all of their hard work. It was great to see all of the parents that attended Parent/Teacher conferences. The district Solo and Ensemble was held on Saturday where band students, orchestra students and vocal music students were competing.

Subject: Capital Improvement Fund Resolution

At the February 12, 2024 Board meeting, a resolution was passed to open a Capital Improvement Fund. This resolution contained a clerical error on page 1 in point 5 where the funds to be used were stated as the winter 2024 property tax levy. The funds to be used are the winter 2023 property tax levy which are collected in 2024.

The recommendation is a motion to amend the resolution to correct the clerical error on page 1, point 5 to reflect the year 2023 instead of 2024.

Rockford Public Schools, Michigan (the “District”)

A regular meeting of the board of education of the District (the “Board”) was held in the Administration building, within the boundaries of the District, on the 12th day of February, 2024, at 5:30 o’clock in the p.m. (the “Meeting”)

The Meeting was called to order by Jarrod Folsom, President.

Present: Members Jarrod Folsom, Kelley Freridge, Jake Himmelspach, Tricia Anderson, Barb Helms, Nick Reichenbach

Absent: Members Christie Ramsey

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member Kelley Freridge and supported by Member Nick Reichenbach:

WHEREAS:

1. The District is engaged in the following project: 2019 Bond Issue (“Project”), which constitutes a “state project” and utilizes “construction mechanics,” as those terms are defined in Public Act 10 of 2023 (“PA 10”); and
2. PA 10 requires that for every state project utilizing construction mechanics, the District must pay prevailing wages to construction mechanics, as determined by the Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity; and
3. PA 10’s Section 9(2) states that PA 10 does not apply to state projects paid, in whole or in part, from a millage that was (A) authorized by the Revised School Code and (B) authorized by voters before PA 10’s effective date (i.e., before February 13, 2024); and
4. On November 8th, 2022, the District’s voters authorized its Operating millage, permitting the District to levy and collect 18 mills from 2023 to 2026, inclusive; and
5. Pursuant to that voter authorization, on the District’s behalf, one or more taxing jurisdictions collected the levied amounts with respect to the winter 2023 property tax levy and remitted payment to the District (“Millage Revenue”); and
6. Any delinquent tax payments related to the Millage Revenue are also considered Millage Revenue; and
7. The District is authorized to create a fund or funds for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, extending, altering, repairing, or equipping public improvements or buildings and to provide appropriations, credits, and transfers to said fund or funds and to provide for disbursement thereof; and
8. The Board is of the opinion that it is in the best interest of the District and its residents and taxpayers for the Board to establish a capital improvement fund, in order to provide for funds needed from time to time for the Project and various other public school improvements, the fund to be composed entirely of Millage Revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Board does hereby create and establish a Capital Improvement Fund (the "Fund") as a special depository account to be kept in Michigan Liquid Asset Fund Bank, Detroit, Michigan, or such other depository as from time to time may be subsequently approved by the Board. The Fund shall be used for the purpose of appropriating, providing for, setting aside, and accumulating Millage Revenue and accrued interest thereon to be used for the Project, including fully or partially funding contracts involving construction mechanics, and otherwise acquiring, constructing, extending, altering, repairing, equipping, or furnishing public school improvements, buildings, sites, facilities or other facilities which the District is authorized to acquire, construct, extend, alter, enlarge, equip, or repair by statute.

2. The Board hereby authorizes and directs the Superintendent, the individual acting in the capacity of the District's school business official, or a designee thereof, to cause the Fund to be established in accordance with the terms of this resolution and to transfer Millage Revenue to the Fund in the amount of \$1,000.00.

3. Other than the Millage Revenue transferred into the Fund pursuant to Paragraph 2, above, and accrued interest thereon, no other moneys or revenues shall be deposited or transferred into the Fund.

4. Millage Revenue transferred into and accumulated in the Fund shall not be transferred, commingled with other funds, encumbered, or otherwise disposed of, except for the purposes of the Fund as established in paragraph 1, above, and shall be governed by all applicable laws.

5. All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby rescinded.

Attached to this memorandum you will find a draft calendar for consideration at the Board of Education meeting on March 11, 2024.

This calendar stems from collaborative conversations with REA and provides a similar calendar to that which was approved for the 2023-2024 school year, with some notable changes which are highlighted below. All parties are at consensus with the draft calendar presented.

Most noteworthy, this calendar 12 early release days and two half days. The decrease in early release days is in an effort to respond to community feedback. You will also note that the early release days are placed more strategically, so as to avoid multiple disruptions in the same week for families while still allowing our staff the needed time to collaborate and adjust instruction to meet the needs of students.

Additionally, we will begin school one week before the Labor Day holiday as opposed to two weeks before Labor Day, which allows us to capture additional instructional time in June before we recess for summer.

We look forward to discussing this calendar and how it will help our district support student learning for the 2024-2025 school year.

OPT OUT OF SECTION 105

Dr. Matthews,

I am pleased to inform you that Rockford Public Schools is continuing to make progress at updating furniture throughout our district. As you recall, the furniture purchase is part of the 2019 Bond to enhance district learning environments.

The district will begin our spring summer work of replacing furniture over spring break and move through the end of August. Cannonsburg will be receiving all new furniture on spring break. All district teacher stations will be replaced and a rolling schedule will start after the Cannonsburg install. Teacher stations included in this approval request include ERMS, NRMS, RFC, RHS and RVA.

Student furniture will also be installed at Edgerton Trails Elementary, Lakes Elementary and Parkside Elementary during the summer. In addition, furniture will be installed in the rooms on the new addition at North Rockford Middle School, as well as in all elementary STEAM rooms. Attached you will find the timeline for installation and estimated budget for the next phase of this project, which includes the aforementioned furniture.

It is important to note that the budget allocated for these purchases currently covers all remaining teacher stations and only the buildings that are scheduled for student furniture in June, July, August and September of 2024. Additional approvals for student furniture at other buildings will be included in packets of future board meetings. The budget proposal total for supporting the furniture renovations between now and the start of the school year is \$4,240,180.68 and details are outlined in the attached packets.

At Monday's meeting we will be seeking board approval of the budget to move forward. If you have any questions or require further information, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Subject: 2024 Curriculum Resource Recommendation: Middle School Social Studies and 9th Grade Pre-AP

Dr. Matthews,

Two of our district's core instructional values are to ensure that we have a guaranteed and viable curriculum (GVC) across the same courses and that we have appropriately high levels of academic rigor for all. This means that every student enrolled in the same course or grade will have equitable and rigorous learning opportunities aligned to state content standards regardless of the teacher they have or school they attend. In order to work towards these district values, we must use a defined district process to continuously evaluate student achievement and review curriculum resources. During Monday's Board of Education meeting, we will be presenting on the resource review process and recommendation rationale for curriculum resources influencing two populations in our district. The first is 6th-8th social studies and the other is 9th Grade English.

Lissa Weidenfeller, North Rockford Middle School Principal, led a district team investigating middle school social studies resources. The team included district curriculum leaders, middle school teachers, and instructional coaches. Criteria included evaluating elements of content standard alignment, teacher/student usability and instructional design. Through establishing intended outcomes, participating in professional learning, piloting instruction in classrooms, collecting data through various rubrics and making a decision through consensus building, I am confident that the process has yielded the recommendation of a resource that will provide increased student learning for all. Also noteworthy, I have been able to apply for the 99D Grant through the State of Michigan to offset costs associated with purchasing a new social studies resource.

Kelly Amshey, Rockford Freshman Center Principal, led a district team including a district instructional director, a department leader, and RFC ELA teachers to investigate and pilot College Board's Pre-AP English to replace English 9 and Honors English 9. The purpose of this investigation was to build tighter elements of a GVC and align to rigor expectations of AP Seminar in 10th grade. We also believe that promoting AP options for all at younger grades can foster a stronger student transcript and strengthen a personal belief for students that might not have felt they were "AP caliber" before. As part of the investigation process, Rockford Freshman Center ELA Teachers attended professional learning during the summer of 2023, piloted four units in all English 9 courses, and spent early release collaborative time reflecting on data and instructional characteristics. In January, the RFC team gathered to review the pilot experience evidence and came to a consensus to recommend College Board's Pre-AP as their primary English 9 resource. There is no cost for aligning our instruction to this College Board Resource.

Both committees have followed our district process for a curriculum resource review and their recommendations are listed below. I support these recommendations as their outcomes align with district instructional values and they will lead to increased levels of learning for all students in our district. The recommendations were presented to the RPS Board of Education Curriculum and Instruction Committee on Thursday, February 15th.

The listed costs for the purchase are based on vendor quotes per our current student population. Exact amounts will be determined after board approval and official ordering.





Subject: Emergency Elevator Part Replacement

The elevator at East Rockford Middle School is failing and requires an emergency equipment replacement of the hydraulic power unit. To get the new hydraulic power unit in time for a Spring Break installation, not disrupt elevator service, and meet safety requirements, we moved forward with placing the order through Kone, who we have used in the past. Kone is also part of a bidding consortium.

A resolution to pay Kone Care for an amount not to exceed \$41,267.00 out of the sinking fund will be presented to the full board at the Board of Education meeting on March 11, 2024 for approval.

WHEREAS, the District requires repairs to the Pass Elevator 35272 located at East Rockford Middle School, which in this extenuating circumstance constitutes an emergency situation given the imminent potential for serious damage if unabated or unrepaired; and

WHEREAS, the Board invokes the limited exception to competitive bidding requirements under the Revised School Code, MCL 380.1267, for emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it would be in the best interests of the District to waive any applicable Board Policies and/or Administrative Guidelines related to competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it would be in the best interests of the District to engage the services of Kone Care ("Contractor") for the emergency repairs, without undergoing competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to authorize and direct Dr. Steve Matthews, the Superintendent, or his designee, to procure material and labor from the Contractor for the emergency repairs in an amount not to exceed \$41,267.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Board hereby authorizes and directs Dr. Steve Matthews, the Superintendent, or his designee, to procure material and labor from the Contractor for the emergency repairs, without undergoing competitive bidding.
2. All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby rescinded.

February 15, 2024

Kelley called the meeting to order at 7:36 a.m.

A moment of silence was observed.

Jarod Folsom and Tricia Anderson were unable to attend, however, the meeting was recorded for Jarrod and Tricia to review.

Welcome

Mike Ramm welcomed all in attendance and shared the purpose of the Board Curriculum and Instruction Council meetings was to engage the RPS Board of Education (BOE) committee members in updates and inquiry about new and ongoing curriculum and instruction initiatives focused on improving student learning for all.

RFC Pre-AP Curriculum Alignment Adoption

Topic Objective: Provide an overview of review rationale and selection criteria regarding ELA curriculum adoption for all 9th grade students.

Details:

- Kelly Amshey reinforced that the district wants a consistent experience for all 9th grade students in regards to the ELA curriculum regardless of teacher or trimester. This experience should set high expectations for learning and result in students having a set of skills that would lend to preparing them for the AP Seminar ELA course in 10th grade.
- Kelly provided an update about characteristics of the Pre-AP pilot process which includes all RFC teachers.
- Tom VanBragt, a 9th grade ELA teacher, stated the timing of the end of the 2nd trimester will complete the pilot and he has noticed his students are writing better than they ever have before. The curriculum pieces together and builds upon itself to culminate in remarkable work that our students are doing evidenced by their deep thinking and writing skills.
- At a recent early release, Sharon Wells provided materials to the 9th grade ELA team to evaluate the curriculum alignment and they were also given a private survey. The results of the survey showed that all teachers were in support of adopting the Pre-AP curriculum for the upcoming school year.

- Recommendation of the council is to move forward with adopting the College Board Pre-AP curriculum beginning with the 24-25 school year based on the evidence of student learning benefits.
- Kelley supports the recommendation and the council will require input from Tricia and Jarod after they review the recorded meeting.

Middle School Social Studies Resource Recommendation

Topic Objective: Provide an overview of review rationale and selection criteria regarding social studies curriculum adoption for all middle school students.

Details:

- Lissa Weidenfeller reminded the council of the pilot process and provided an update as to where in the process the middle school social studies pilot currently stands.
- Lissa reminded the council of the district's need for a guaranteed and viable social studies curriculum that aligns directly with State of Michigan Content Standards. The district is concluding a pilot process of curriculum from TCI and McGraw Hill, two of the most popular resources in West Michigan schools.
- Through a consensus selection process from pilot teachers, the district has recommended moving forward with McGraw Hill. One key element is that this resource more easily provides immediate data that assists in the PLC collaborative process. It also aligns completely to the state standards. In addition, the curriculum provides a version written in Spanish that the Spanish Immersion teachers have reviewed and they are very excited about.
- Recommendation of the council is to move forward with adopting the McGraw Hill middle school social studies resources beginning after spring break of this year based on the evidence of student learning benefits and alignment with the state of Michigan standards.
- Mike Ramm reminded the council this curriculum will round out resource adoptions for all core areas at the middle school level. This was a three year process.
- Kelley supports the recommendation and the council will require input from Tricia and Jarod after they review the recorded meeting

Elementary Literacy Curriculum Review Update

Topic Objective: Update the council on the elementary literacy piloting process, timeline and early observations.

Details:

- Sharon Wells reminded the council of the pilot process and provided an update as to where in the process the elementary literacy pilot currently stands.
- The pilot is half way through the 8-week process which includes 47 teachers and approximately 1,000 students. At this mid-point, teachers were given a survey that has provided positive feedback and both resource companies have also provided mid-point training with Q&A opportunities.
- Both curriculum resources involved in the pilot meet all 5 pillars of fluency and raise learning expectations for students while supporting instructors with adequate materials.
- The state released grant money available for the next two years for districts to support literacy review, curriculum purchase and professional development. We have applied for this grant money and expect to receive it, funding a large portion of this endeavor.
- The pilot will be complete this spring and a purchase recommendation will be brought to the Board of Education for monies outside of what will be available through the grant.

2024/25 School Year District Calendar

Topic Objective: Discuss observations and reflections from the 2023-24 calendar and to provide rationale behind the draft of the 2024-25 calendar.

Details:

- Korie Wilson-Crawford presented a draft of the 2024-2025 school calendar to the council which was created with combined, collaborative effort with the REA.
- Noted differences
 - Start-day of 8/26/24 which is one week before Labor Day as opposed to two weeks before Labor Day as was the case for the 23-24 school year.
 - The last day of school is scheduled for 6/6/25 as opposed to 5/30/2025.
 - 13 early release days compared to the 18 early release days from the 23-24 school year
 - The district took community feedback into consideration where early releases didn't "make sense" but yet scheduled them to still promote the 2 week inquiry.
 - 1/20/25 Martin Luther King (MLK) Day will be a day off for students and a professional learning day for staff focused on cultural awareness and student belonging. We feel this change will give us increased opportunity to honor the holiday and align district knowledge and classroom lessons around Dr. King's teachings.
 - The Friday before Memorial Day is now a non-report day for students and staff
- Mid-winter break will remain intact, as well as the remaining school breaks which align with the KISD calendar which we are required to follow.
- Para professional and support staff professional development will occur on an early release day, once a trimester, as is the case for the 23-24 school year, and the calendar is set in collaboration with RESPA.
- The 24-25 draft calendar will go to the Board of Education in the March for approval.
