

French Back-to-Back Middle School Student Cultural Exchange Program

The French Back-to-Back (FB2B) program is a cultural exchange program run through French American Cultural Exchange Program (FACEP) in Jackson, MI, in coordination with La Ligue in France.

General Information:

- Any student entering grades 6-9.
- Rockford students matched with student group from France.
 - Communicate prior to visits
- French students come to Rockford for two weeks.
 - October 2019 or February 2020
 - Stay with families to experience American family life.
 - Parents plan and chaperone week day activities for French group.
 - Start each day at NRMS.
 - American kids go to school.
 - Weekends are family time.
- Rockford students travel to France in June 2020, after school lets out.
 - Stay with families to experience French family life.
 - French families plan activities for our kids.
 - 2 chaperones (Melissa Schmidt, teacher at NRMS & Laura Bargwell, Rockford parent and FB2B parent 3 times!)
- Notes
 - You do not need to know or plan to study French!
 - Visiting students need their own bed, but not necessarily their own room.
 - No need for a big or fancy house. We are showing them real America!
