2. 2020-21 Snow Days (=>

Assistant Superintendent of Instruction Mike Ramm will report to the Board of Education on guidelines for snow days for the 2020-21 school year, which will mirror past practice with cancellations applying to all certified staff and students, no matter their educational arrangement. Mr. Ramm will also share with the Board academic enrichment resources available to families wishing to use them on snow days or at any time.

3. COVID-19 Testing Partnership

Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources Korie Wilson-Crawford will report to the Board of Education on a partnership RPS has established with Mercy Health and Arctic Medical Laboratories to provide COVID testing for students and staff.

I. OLD BUSINESS

1. Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan Reconfirmation Hearing

In compliance with Public Act 149, the Board of Education approved the Rockford Public Schools Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan in September. The Act requires that the Board of

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Education reconfirm the district's Extended CLP every 30 days, therefore, Superintendent Shibler will present this for Board consideration on a monthly basis.

Dr. Shibler will report to the Board of Education on rationale for maintaining in-person instruction for elementary students while moving the middle and high schools to remote teaching and learning.

Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources Korie Wilson-Crawford will update the Board of Education on MIOSHA requirements relative to staff working from home or the school during periods of remote teaching and learning. Ms. Wilson-Crawford will present a proposed policy outlining the district's compliance with MIOSHA to be included as an addendum to the Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan.

As part of the reconfirmation process, Assistant Superintendent of Instruction Mike Ramm will report to the Board of Education any modifications made to the original Extended Learning Plan and whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students or other special populations. Mr. Ramm will also report on successes, challenges, and student attendance rates. Following Mr. Ramm's report, President Postema will provide an opportunity for parents/guardians to provide input regarding the Plan.

Following Board of Education discussion, Dr. Shibler will provide a recommendation regarding the reconfirmation of the district's Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan. All reconfirmation documents will be made available on the transparency reporting page on the district website.
