1. Student Representative

2. COVID-19 District Response

Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources Korie Wilson-Crawford, along with District Nurse Kelly Theaker and Director of Security Scott Beckman, will report to the Board of Education on the district's coordinated response to managing COVID-19 in our schools.

I. OLD BUSINESS

1. Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan Reconfirmation Hearing

In compliance with Public Act 149, the Board of Education approved the Rockford Public Schools Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan in September. The Act requires that the Board of Education reconfirm the district's Extended CLP every 30 days, therefore, Superintendent Shibler will present this for Board consideration on a monthly basis.

As part of the reconfirmation process, Assistant Superintendent of Instruction Mike Ramm will report to the Board of Education any modifications made to the original Extended Learning Plan and whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English

language learners, special education students or other special populations. Mr. Ramm will also report on successes, challenges, and student attendance rates.

This month, Mr. Ramm will also report on the district's compliance with the requirement to post a report on the district's website transparency reporting link outlining "Training on Delivery, Access, and Use of Virtual Content," which describes the amount and type of training provided to teachers through professional development on how to deliver virtual content.

Following Mr. Ramm's report, President Postema will provide an opportunity for parents/guardians to provide input regarding the Plan.

Following public input and Board of Education discussion, Dr. Shibler will provide a recommendation regarding the reconfirmation of the district's Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan. All reconfirmation documents will be made available on the transparency reporting page on the district website.

J. NEW BUSINESS

1. DTE Natural Gas Easement Resolution

Assistant Superintendent of Finance Mike Cuneo will report to the Board of Education on a recommendation to change the classification of an existing easement which will allow for natural gas extension to the new team rooms at Carlson-Munger Stadium. Dr. Shibler will recommend the Board of Education adopt the resolution approving the recommendation by roll call vote.

2. 2019-20 Financial Audit

Assistant Superintendent of Finance Mike Cuneo will summarize the 2019-20 financial audit conducted by Hungerford Nichols CPAs + Advisors. The Board of Education received a detailed presentation at an earlier study session. Following Mr. Cuneo's report, Dr. Shibler will recommend the Board of Education accept the 2019-20 financial audit as presented.
