Student Representative

RHS student representative Bella MacKenzie reported to the Board of Education on last week's homecoming activities, athletics and fine arts, the addition of Gunner the therapy dog to the school,

mental health awareness and student council activities, and support provided from Beyond the Rock through event livestreams.

Rockford Education Foundation

On behalf of the Rockford Education Foundation Board of Directors and administration, REF Chair Amy Vancil announced to the Board of Education the establishment of the Dr. Michael Shibler Scholarship in honor of Dr. Shibler's 32+ years as Superintendent of the Rockford Public Schools. The scholarship has been established to honor Dr. Shibler's impact on the district and community and will be awarded to an outstanding student who has shown fortitude and dedication.

Therapy Dog Program

Executive Director of Special Services Mindy Duba reported to the Board of Education on the district's therapy dog program and introduced Gunner, RHS's newest certified therapy dog and his handler RHS counselor Rachel Kreuze. Gunner is the district's second therapy dog, joining Chillie, who has been at North Rockford Middle School since 2019. The district's therapy dogs are trained through the Interquest CARES (Comfort, Assist, Reassure, Encourage, Support) Program. Data supports not only the emotional benefits for students and adults but also increased attendance and performance. The district's therapy dog program is possible through support from the Rockford Education Foundation and Rogue Valley Veterinary Hospital, and the district hopes to expand the program to other schools.
