G. OLD BUSINESS

1. Spring and Fall Policy Updates (Second Reading)

2. RAMS XI (Second Reading)

Following a first reading on November 8, 2021, and two years of planning, Dr. Shibler recommends that the Board of Education adopt the district's three-year blueprint for continuous improvement, effective January 1, 2022.

H. NEW BUSINESS (=>

1. Bid Recommendations – New Buses

Mr. Cuneo will present to the Board of Education a recommendation to purchase seven 71-passenger and one 47-passenger buses from Hoekstra at a total cost of \$798,531.00. Dr. Shibler will recommend that the Board of Education approve the purchase of the school buses.

2. Bid Recommendations – Track Hurdles

Mr. Cuneo will present to the Board of Education a recommendation to purchase 125 track hurdles for Rockford High School at a cost of \$47,955.00 from STAR. Dr. Shibler will recommend the Board of Education approve the purchase of the hurdles.
