At the Board of Education meeting on March 11, the Board took the following action:

The 2024-2025 school calendar was approved. I have attached a calendar link: 2024-2025 RPS Calendar.docx

- School begins on August 26
- Twelve early release Wednesdays are included These days allow our teachers to focus on student instructional needs, plan and prepare lessons, additional support, and lesson extensions for our students.
- Our Holiday break begins at the end of the school day on December 20 We return to school from our Holiday break on Monday, January 6
- Students have off Martin Luther King Jr. Day, January 20 Staff will report for professional development
- Mid-winter break is Friday, February 14 and Monday, February, 17
- Spring break begins at the end of the school day on Wednesday, April 2 We return to school on Monday, April 14
- Our last day of school is June 6 The last two days of school Thursday, June 5 and Friday, June 6 are half days
- The Board approved Rachel Dekuiper as the next principal at Belmont Elementary
- The Board accepted the retirement of Larry Watters, principal at Parkside Elementary.
